Since 2022, the Office of the Attorney General Financial Recovery Section ("OAG") has worked with the Department of Medical Assistance Services ("DMAS") to determine lien amounts concerning third-party negligence claims by Virginia's Medicaid members.

Effective immediately, please note the following updated guidelines:

- All new lien requests must continue to be sent to <u>tplcasualty@dmas.virginia.gov</u>.
- If a lien determination was requested via email <u>before April 1, 2024</u>, to <u>tplcasualty@dmas.virginia.gov</u>, the lien determination will be determined by the OAG and notice of lien will come from the OAG.
- If a lien determination was requested via email on or after April 1, 2024, to tplcasualty@dmas.virginia.gov, the lien determination will be determined by DMAS and notice of lien will come from DMAS.
- All requests for a lien update or lien reduction must be sent to <u>tplcasualty@dmas.virginia.gov</u>.
 - o If DMAS receives a request for a lien reduction based upon specific circumstance(s), DMAS will forward the same to the OAG for review and approval pursuant to applicable authority.
