On June 17, 2024, Brent Lavelle Barbour filed a petition for reinstatement of his license to practice law with the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board (Disciplinary Board) pursuant to Part 6, § IV, Paragraph 13-25 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia. On January 6, 2026, the Disciplinary Board forwarded the record of proceedings in the matter, including a recommendation that the petition for reinstatement be granted, to this Court.

The Court, having considered the recommendation of the Disciplinary Board, approves the petition for reinstatement. Reinstatement is conditioned upon petitioner paying the outstanding costs assessed in connection with the reinstatement proceedings and passing the written portion of the Virginia State Bar Examination. Final action will be taken by the Court upon receipt of evidence that the petitioner has met these requirements.
