**RULE TO SHOW CAUSE AND
ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION AND HEARING**

It appearing to the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board ("the Board") that Patrick Ross Macaluso was licensed to practice law within the Commonwealth of Virginia on February 15, 2018, and,

It further appearing that on May 15, 2026, Patrick Ross Macaluso ("Respondent") entered a guilty plea in Case Number **C12CR25-772** to Sexual Solicitation of a Minor, and Child Porn Solicit Subject, in the Harford, Maryland.

It further appearing that Patrick Ross Macaluso has been convicted of Crimes, as defined by the Rules of Court, Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-22 A.,

It is **ORDERED**, pursuant to the Rules of Court, Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-22, that the license of Patrick Ross Macaluso to practice law within the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and the same is, hereby **SUSPENDED, effective June 5, 2026**.

It is further **ORDERED** that Patrick Ross Macaluso appear before the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board at the **State Corporation Commission, Courtroom A, Second Floor, Tyler Building, 1300 East Main Street, Richmond, VA 23219, at 9:00 a.m. on June 26, 2026**, to show cause why his license to practice law within the Commonwealth of Virginia should not be further suspended or revoked.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Respondent must comply with the requirements of Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-29 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia. The Respondent must forthwith give notice by certified mail of the Suspension of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia, to all clients for whom he is currently handling matters and to all opposing Attorneys and presiding Judges in pending litigation. The Respondent must also make appropriate arrangements for the disposition of matters then in his care in conformity with the wishes of his clients. The Respondent must give such notice immediately and in no event later than fourteen (14) days of the effective date of the Suspension, and make such arrangements as are required herein as soon as is practicable and in no event later than forty-five (45) days of the effective date of the Suspension. The Respondent must also furnish proof to the Clerk of the Disciplinary System of the Virginia State Bar within sixty (60) days of the effective date of the Suspension that such notices have been timely given and such arrangements have been made for the disposition of matters.

It is further **ORDERED** that if the Respondent is not handling any client matters on the effective date of the Suspension, he shall submit an affidavit to that effect within sixty (60) days of the effective date of the Suspension to the Clerk of the Disciplinary System at the Virginia State Bar. The Board must decide all issues concerning the adequacy of the notice and arrangements required herein. The burden of proof shall be on the Respondent to show compliance. If the Respondent fails to show compliance, the Board may impose a sanction of Revocation or additional Suspension for failure to comply with the requirements of subparagraph 13-29.

It is further **ORDERED** that a copy of the Criminal Indictment, Statement of Charges Case Portal (Redacted), and Case Summary (Redacted), be attached to this Rule to Show Cause and Order of Summary Suspension and Hearing and made a part hereof.

It is further **ORDERED** that an attested copy of this Show Cause and Order of Summary Suspension and Hearing, with attachments, be mailed by the Clerk to the Respondent by electronic, first-class, and certified mail to his address of record with the Virginia State Bar, being 74 Glasgow Way, Hampton, Virginia 23669, and a copy to an alternate address, being 36 Amy Brooks Drive, Newport News, Virginia 23606, and a copy by electronic mail to Craig M. Kadish, Respondent's Counsel, and a copy by electronic mail to Seth T. Shelley, Assistant Bar Counsel.

On July 24, 2025, Detective Sergeant was conducting a proactive undercover investigation for solicitation of sex and sex acts from minors online, using the undercover identity of Nate, who made a post in the Reddit sub-forum "Boys ask Dads", identifying himself as a 14 year old boy looking for advice on "coming out" to his parents. Nate was engaged in a private chat by user "furrymillennial", who identified himself as a 36 year old, married male, whose first name was Patrick. During the exchange Nate's age of 14 and the fact that he was young and inexperienced was brought up numerous times and furthermore this in particular was acknowledged by Patrick on multiple occasions.

This chat was moved over to text message when Patrick provided his phone number of [REDACTED] 1905. Detective Sergeant utilized investigative databases to find that this phone number was owned by Verizon Wireless and issued to Patrick Ross Macaluso, [REDACTED]-1988, of Hampton, Virginia.

Conversation carried on through the next several days, in which Macaluso asked intimate and sexual questions and was engaged in sexual conversation with the persona of Nate. Macaluso further sent multiple inappropriate photographs showing himself holding his erect penis under his clothing, in his underwear, and lying in his bed. Macaluso stated that he worked for the City of Suffolk, as a City Attorney, and that he had free time to chat during the day from his private office. Multiple photos of Macaluso were taken from what appeared to be and was later identified as an office used for his employment with the City of Suffolk.

On July 29, 2025, while engaging in sexual conversation with who he believed to be a 14 year old male, Macaluso solicited Nate to masturbate with him via utilization of a web cam to conduct a video chat with him. It was brought to Macaluso's attention that if they were to do that Nate's penis would be erect and there was concern that someone else may see, to which Macaluso advised it would only be the two of them. Detective Sergeant knows through his training knowledge and experience that a common method for the production of child sexual abuse material is done through screen recording of video chats.

Shortly before this portion of the conversation Macaluso advised that he wished that Nate was with him in Virginia, and when it was brought to Macaluso's attention that Nate was too young to drive, Macaluso advised that he wished Nate's parents were away the following weekend because he would drive up to meet him. Macaluso then described that he wanted to kiss Nate, touch him all over, get his clothes off, hold him, explore his body, help Nate explore Macaluso's body and make him "feel incredible and cared for". Macaluso further advised that he wanted to bring a "fleshlight" (a device for male masturbation) and show Nate how to use it and let him have the item.

Sexual conversations continued with Macaluso and who he believed to be a 14 year old male through August 13, 2024. These conversations included detailed sex acts described by Macaluso directed at Nate, including oral sex and sodomy. It should be noted that through these conversations Nate's young age, inability to drive and preparing to enter high school were a constant point of conversation as well.

During conversation of the course of several days, Macaluso further provided information that his middle name was Ross, thus confirming the identity made by Detective Sergeant. This was further substantiated upon viewing the driver's license photo of Macaluso through Virginia DMV, which matched with photos sent by Macaluso.

NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL FOR ALL JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
2. If you have been arrested and remain in custody, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five(5) days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be cancelled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
4. You have the right to have a lawyer.
5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
 - (A) explaining the charges in this paper;
 - (B) telling you the possible penalties;
 - (C) explaining any potential collateral consequences of a conviction, including immigration consequences;
 - (D) helping you at trial;
 - (E) helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
 - (F) helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court-appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.2 to review an order of a District Court commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceeding, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. To apply for Public Defender representation, contact a District Court commissioner.
8. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
