CONSENT ORDER OF IMPAIRMENT SUSPENSION

WHEREAS the Virginia State Bar requests entry of an order suspending the license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia of Ashkira Hassan Mohamud, on the basis that Ms. Mohamud has an Impairment as that term is defined in Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia; and

WHEREAS Ms. Mohamud acknowledges and represents that she is suffering from an Impairment as that term is defined in Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia; and

WHEREAS Ms. Mohamud and Dale Mullen, counsel for Ms. Mohamud, consent to the entry of an order suspending Ms. Mohamud's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on the basis that Ms. Mohamud has an Impairment as that term is defined in Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia; and

WHEREAS the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board hereby finds that Ms. Mohamud suffers from an Impairment as that term is defined in Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia and that the underlying condition materially impairs Ms. Mohamud's fitness to practice law.

Based on the forgoing and the consent of Ashkira Hassan Mohamud; Dale Mullen, counsel for Ms. Mohamud; and the Virginia State Bar, and it otherwise appearing proper to do so, it is hereby ORDERED, pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-23 of the Rules of the Supreme

Court of Virginia, that Ms. Mohamud's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall be and hereby is SUSPENDED indefinitely upon entry of this Order due to Impairment and shall remain suspended until it is established that she no longer suffers from an Impairment.

It is further ORDERED that Ms. Mohamud shall give notice, by certified mail, of the suspension of her license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia to all clients for whom she is currently handling matters and to all opposing attorneys and presiding judges in pending litigation, and shall make appropriate arrangements for the disposition of any matters presently in her care in conformity with the wishes of her clients, pursuant to the requirements of Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-29 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia.


It is further ORDERED that the Clerk of the Disciplinary System shall send a certified copy of this Order by certified mail to Ashkira Hassan Mohamud, Respondent, at Law Office of Ashkira H.
